A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE RADIO STATION.....

Alex FM was the brainchild of eight residents - consisting of former Great Southern FM announcers and Goolwa Business Owners on 12th November 2001.

Mr Jackson was named Chairman and Dee Elliott as Vice Chairman and each member put in \$50.

By 4th January 2002 Alex FM became incorporated and on 18th January, submitted an application with the ACMA for a temporary license.

By Christmas 2003, the station had equipment to record programs and play them on the narrow cast channel .

In 2004, a temporary Community License was awarded on 96.5 to share with the Christian Broadcasters. The station went on to establish new equipment to give them a link to Kirby Hill tower.

Alex FM had 50 members with 16 volunteering as on air Presenters, with live broadcasts from 6am to 9pm with a music mix throughout the night. Others helped with Production, Sales and in the Office.

In 2012 Radio Goolwa Alex FM gained their Long Term License on Wednesday 30th May 2012.
